The new library features resources for job seekers, Wi-Fi, public computer access for adults, early childhood and afterschool programs, and an on-site collection of career and children's books with easy access to York County Libraries collection of 700,000 items. It is free to use the library services, so be sure to swing by during operating hours.

We also hope you will join us for the Grand Opening Celebration from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. Sunday, April 9 in front of the library. Following a ribbon-cutting ceremony at 2 p.m., there will be tours of the library, live music, food, games, and children's book give-away. It is free to attend, so please come! If there is bad weather, the celebration is moving inside to Martin Library, which is located at 159 E. Market Street.
